Notification

The 29th October, 2002

No. GSR 19/Const./ Art. 309/2002.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group B Service Rules, 1986, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group B Service (Amendment) Rules, 2002.

2. In the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group B Service Rules, 1986 (hereinafter called the said rules), in rule 12, after sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be added, namely :--

“(3) A member of the Service appointed on or after 1st January, 1996 shall be liable to serve in the rural area for a minimum total period of five years out of which at least three years should be prior to placement in senior scale and at least two years prior to award of selection grade. He/ She shall, however, be free to opt to do the service in rural area for a period of five years at a stretch prior to the award of senior scale.”

3. In the said rules for Appendix A and B the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely :—
